- NMMATYC honors members by induction to the NMMATYC Hall of Fame Teaching Award.
- A NMMATYC annual conference is held each spring.
- In odd numbered years the conference is a joint effort between NMMATYC and the Southwest Section of MAA.
- NMMATYC supports the 2007 Southwest AMATYC Regional Conference in San Antonio, Texas.
- NMMATYC provides a liaison to the New Mexico Partnership for Science and Math Education.
